First place winners' artworks will be published as Imagine That! greeting cards and prizes will be awarded for grades k-6 and 7-12. To enter, create an artwork that illustrates the opposite of bullying -- KINDNESS.

TIPS FOR CREATING YOUR ARTWORK

1. Create a picture that illustrates KINDNESS. For example, show someone feeding an animal or people helping each other at school, at home, or another place.
2. You can add a slogan or saying. For example, "kindness Makes the World Go Around" "We Can Change the World with Kindness," or any other saying.
3. You can add an element of fantasy. For example, you can show people holding hands around the globe.
4. Make your artwork in color.

PRIZES: First place winners will have artwork published as Imagine That! greeting cards and will receive a set of cards.
